

PRGMEA holds seminar on WeBoc

(Karachi, October 11, 2011): Pakistan Readymade Garments Manufacturers & Exports Association (PRGMEA) in collaboration with Pakistan Customs held an introductory seminar on October 11, 2011 on recently introduced WeBoc clearance system introduced by Pakistan Customs for import and export consignment clearance in which large numbers of PRGMEA members attended the seminar. Mr. Atiq Kochra, Zonal Chairman, PRGMEA in his welcome address thanked Mr. Ibrahim Vighio and his team for taking his out his precious time and introducing the new system and answering member's queries. He emphasized on the development of such systems, with the use of technology, to increase the efficiency of the exporters and bring down the cost and time of doing business.
